This decision will impact students, teachers, families, and the McCoyneighborhood for years to come—we must make sure our voices are heard. Urge the CFBISD to vote NO to consolidate schools and close McCoy on March 6, 2025.

PERFORMANCE AND SCHOOL RANKING

MCCOY IS THE #1 RANKED ELEMENTARY IN CFBISD

- McCoy is the #1 ranked elementary school in CFBISD. with high achievement across both LEAP and general education students.
- Notably, 3rd and 4th grade math STAAR results, which are not impacted by LEAP students, are ranked #1 in the district.
- The culture of excellence at McCoy benefits all students
- High teacher retention rate gives consistency to the school and is shown in the students' success and achievement rates.

LACK OF TRANSPARENCY

THE REASONSINGS FOR CHOOSING MCCOY DON'T ADD UP

- The district hasn't explained how closing McCoy will help to save \$9 million in the budget
- They also haven't explained the projection of savings for the future or any other long term solutions
- The district asked for an advisory group of community members to create a rubric to decide which campuses to close; however, no McCoy Elementary members were involved in this process. Also, there has been no transparency on how the rubric was used to select McCoy over other schools.





NEGATIVE CONSEQUENCES ON ENROLLMENT

CLOSING MCCOY AND MOVING LEAP WILL HAVE A NEGATIVE IMPACT ON THE DISTRICT

- Many parents have already stated that if the district closes McCoy and moves Leap to the far side of the district boundary, they will look for other options in other districts or private schools.
- Out of district enrollment (45% of elementary LEAP) could decline due to the distance they'd need to drive to access the program as well as the potential lack of trained and experienced educators at a new campus.

NEGATIVE CONSEQUENCES ON PROPERTY VALUES

HOMES NEAR MCCOY MAY LOSE PROPERTY VALUE

- Many people buy and have bought homes zoned for McCoy as the home campus because it is ranked #1 in the district.
- Closing McCoy could see these property values reduced due to not being zoned for a high ranked school.
